## **Project Victor**

Progress continues on the body work, main job lately has been on the scuttle/windscreen area, once the windscreen was removed, the full extent of corrosion was revealed and the process of repair began.



First job was to make up templates to help maintain the profile then cutting out the rot, a small section at a time, making up new sections, clamping them in place and cutting out another couple of inches until the repaired area is ready to be welded up.



After dressing the welded repair I was intending to lead load the area, but the close proximity of the plastic dash top made this a no-no, so a good quality filler was used to recreate the profile using the pre made templates to maintain the original shape.



Several coats of primer filler and stopper and the job was completed on the passenger's side, then the same process on driver side.



Quite a time consuming job, but a very satisfying feeling when finished.
