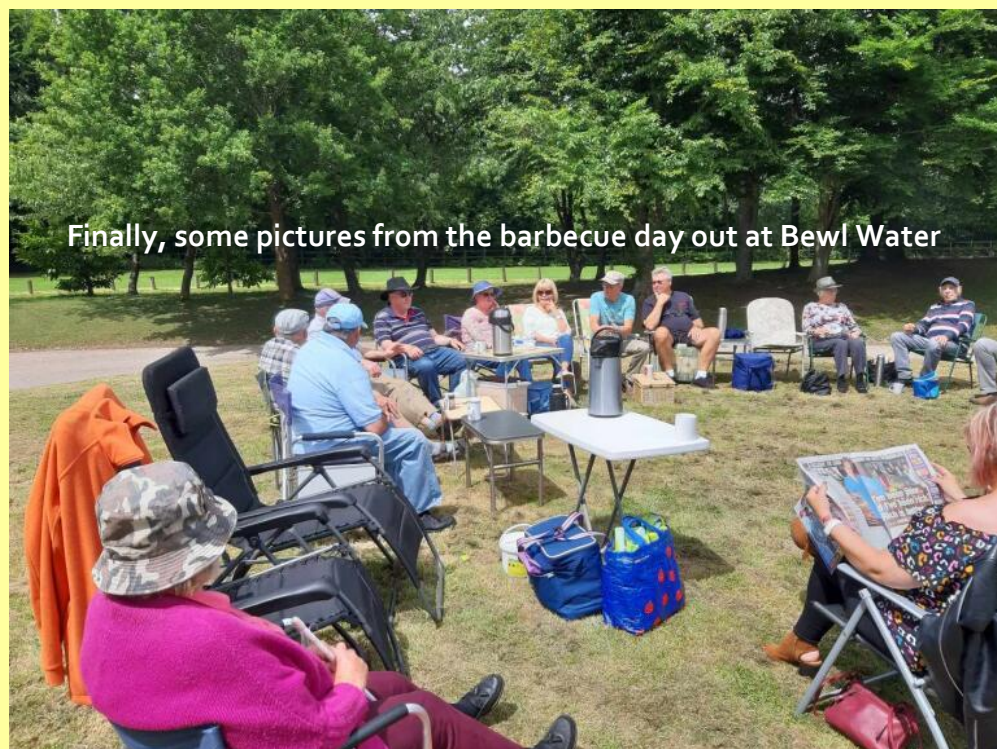

Our Chairman

Well our chairman has injured himself and decided it would be a good time to try out a new mode of transport.

Project Victor

Hi Folks: Things have been a bit slow with the Victor this month, rather a lot going on domestically.

Reassembly work is well underway, rear lights cleaned and fitted, I also managed to acquire a reversing light kit that fits in the main cluster (factory optional extra) complete with wiring kit to gearbox inhibitor switch.



Next was fitting the number plate lights into the rear bumper, fitting the rear bumper irons and bumper. Front and rear wing capping's next, complete with stainless trim, offside fitted well but the nearside were replacement units made from anodised aluminium, I prepared them with 600 grit, applied acid etch primer and several top coats and left them all for about 6 weeks for the paint to harden.



Fitting the stainless trim to the capping's required the use of masking tape to hold the trim in place while fitting, once secured on the new fixings, removing the masking lifted the paint off in several places (OH! Dam, I said under my breath).



So, I have now managed to acquire replacement steel capping's that are now in the process of being prepared for painting. The parcel shelf has also had a refurb and is looking good, Radio repaired and fitted complete with new aerial.



The wood dash trim was looking a bit sun bleached so I ordered some new oak veneer and applied it over the original, and I'm now preparing it for French-polishing,

Still one or two issues with paint on two of the doors, but hopefully they will polish up ok.

Ordered a new set of bumper bolts for the front bumper, but it can't be fitted until the n/s wing capping's are fitted.



I had the old tyres removed from the rims last week, stripped and repainted them and had new tyres fitted. Both sills have now been wax-oiled internally and my next job will be filling the brake system with fluid and attempting to bleed them, (that will be fun!).



A trip to East Kent Trim Supplies is coming up soon to get the new door seals (that won't be cheap).

That's about it for this month folks, still plenty to do, but the weather is getting colder, so the working days will be getting shorter.
